



Rules – Men's Rated Curling Regular Season

Time of Play:

Be prepared to start your game when your sheet of ice is ready for play.

The bell will be used for the 6:45 draws. Once the buzzer goes off, finish the end in play and one more. Games can be rescheduled. Check with the office for available ice times. All rescheduled games MUST be completed prior to the last scheduled game.

Substitutions:

A team MUST have at least 3 players, 2 being regular players, or the game is Forfeited. If the team is regularly a 3 person team, then one of the spares is considered regular for the above ruling.

For spares, please try the Monday Night spare list first. If unsuccessful, then any living male club member will do.

For games when there is no OCA sanctioned game conflicts, all spares must play Front End (Lead or Second) – everyone else moves up one position. If sparing for a 3 man team the spare MUST play lead.

IF a player cannot play a scheduled game because he is in an OCA sanctioned game on the same night, then that player is allowed to substitute a player of equal or less rating to fill in at his rated position. Eg, if a skip is playing in an OCA game on the same night as his rated game, then he can get another rated skip to substitute for him for the rated game, and the rated skip can play the skip position for that game. The other players on the team play their normal positions.

Scoring:

Play at least 6 ends. Play 7th and 8th ends as needed **for the win**.

Win = 10 points, Tie = 5 Points

Ends Points (first 6 ends only): End won = 1 point, End tied or blank = ½ point.

No ends points for 7th and 8th ends.

In case of a forfeit/default – 14 points will go to the team not in forfeit/default and 0 points for the forfeited/defaulted team.
